## Love *Zaagidiwin*

Mutual and unconditional.  
To know peace is to know love.



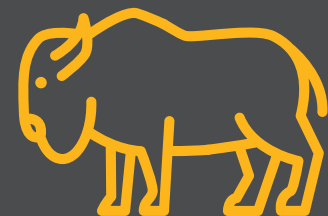
## Bravery *Aakodewewin*

Face the foe with integrity.  
To do what is right even when the consequences are unpleasant.



## Honesty *Gwayakwaadiziwin*

Honesty in facing a situation is to be brave. Always be honest in word and action.



## Respect *Minaadendamowin*

Give respect to be respected.  
Honor all creation.



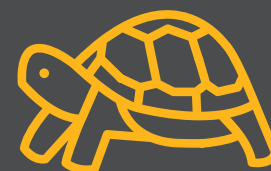
## Wisdom *Nibwaakawin*

Cherish knowledge for the good of the people.



## Humility *Dibaadendiziwin*

Equal to others, not better.  
Compassion, calmness, patience.



## Truth *Debwewin*

To know all of these seven teachings and speak the truth.
